

SPRING SIGNATURE MIX

Plant in Spring after danger of frost has passed

- Soybeans, Cowpeas, Sunflowers, Buckwheat, Sorghum
- Warm-season "catch-all" when it comes to target species and primarily provides great forage options for deer
- Legumes in this mix provide great sources of nitrogen in the soil

ULTIMATE PROTEIN MIX

Plant from June to early August

- Soybeans, Cowpeas, Lab Lab, Sunn Hemp
- Indeterminate soybeans will have vegetative regrowth as long as the main node has not been browsed down
- Provides high levels of protein and nutrients for antler regrowth and milk production during nutritional stress in the summer

FALL SIGNATURE MIX

Plant from September on after soil temperatures begin to drop

- Triticale, Wheat, Oats, Clover, Rape, Radish, Winter Peas
- Cool-season "catch-all" when it comes to target species and primarily provides great forage options for deer
- With a mix of small grains, brassicas, and legumes this mix provides great soil health benefits in addition to forage

SPRING/SUMMER

SPRING SIGNATURE MIX



Soybeans, Cowpeas, Sunflowers, Buckwheat, Sorghum

Well-rounded mix for all wildlife species that provides balanced nutrition during the spring and summer months. Great variety of seed with staggering maturities to prolong your plot. Produces well on all soil types.

*PLANTING RATE: 40 lbs./acre - 60 lbs./acre

ULTIMATE PROTEIN MIX



Soybeans, Cowpeas, Lab Lab, Sunn Hemp

An annual warm-season mix designed for overall animal health by providing high-quality, digestible protein options. High protein levels from this mix provide nutrition during periods of antler regrowth and milk production, especially during the harsh summer weather.

PLANTING DATE: Mid-April - July
*PLANTING RATE: 40 lbs./acre - 60 lbs./acre
TARGET SPECIES: Deer, Turkey

UPLAND BIRD MIX



Millets, Sorghum, Sesame, Egyptian Wheat

The variety in this mix maximizes seed production at different times throughout the year. Egyptian Wheat adds diversity and provides shelter and cover for small game birds. Great mix for dove fields if planted early enough to mature by season opening.

PLANTING DATE: Mid-April - Early June
*PLANTING RATE: 20 lbs./acre - 40 lbs./acre
TARGET SPECIES: Dove, Pheasant, Quail, Turkey



Millets, Sorghum, Buckwheat

Great addition to a moist soil duck management strategy, with better stalk strength and stalk height to withstand flooding. Variety of grains with staggering maturities to provide ample forage and create habitat for insects important to waterfowl nutrition.

PLANTING DATE: Mid April - August
*PLANTING RATE: 15 lbs./acre - 25 lbs./acre
TARGET SPECIES: Waterfowl, also great for deer and upland birds



Conventional and Carolina/Charleston Gold Rice

Rice blend with differing heights and maturities to prolong forage availability. This blend can be planted in dryland, or in a shallow flood up to 12 inches. Does not like brackish or salt water.

PLANTING DATE: April - Early June
*PLANTING RATE: 80 lbs./acre - 120 lbs./acre
TARGET SPECIES: Waterfowl

PLANTING DATE: September - October *PLANTING RATE: 6 lbs./acre - 8 lbs./acre TARGET SPECIES: Deer

SMALL GRAINS MIX

Oats, Wheat, Triticale

Economical forage mix with different grains providing forage at different times throughout the season. Great to top seed into perennial clovers or our Fall Clover Blend. Cereal grains provide a good source of nutrition when natural forage declines during fall/winter.

PLANTING DATE: September - November *PLANTING RATE: 80 lbs./acre - 120 lbs./acre TARGET SPECIES: Deer, Turkey, Quail

Winter Peas, Oats, Triticale, Clover, Vetch, Ryegrass, Turnips, Radish

Hearty winter mix for deer and turkey. Suitable for all soil types and great for improving soil health as well. This is a great late fall to early winter plot mix to provide forage options later in the season and harsher winter months.
